- ▶ Is PURITY a part of your work ethic?
(1 Peter 2:9-15; Ephesians 5:3-10; Matthew 5:13-16; Matthew 5:8)
- ▶ Is your work ultimately about PRODUCTS or PEOPLE?
(Matthew 6:19-24, 33; 1 Timothy 6:7-11; 2 Timothy 2:20-21; Matthew 16:27)
- ▶ Are you a COMPASSIONATE CO-WORKER?
(Matt. 9:35-38; Luke 10:25-37; Matt. 5:43-48; 2 Cor. 1:3-5; Colossians 3:12)
- ▶ When you receive an OPPORTUNITY, will you share your TESTIMONY?
(Colossians 4:2-6; Ephesians 5:15-16; 1 Peter 3:8-22)

Reflect on the following Scriptures this week:

Colossians 3:22-25; Exodus 35:30-36:5; 1 Peter 2:9-25;
1 Peter 3:8-22; Luke 10:25-37; Colossians 4:2-6

Is the quality of your work a witness to the ability and skill God has given you? Are there areas that you are allowing yourself to do the minimum?

Examine your language, attitude and behaviors among your co-workers. Would they be surprised if you told them you went to church? Does your life show them that Jesus would make a difference in their lives?
